Across the Universe!

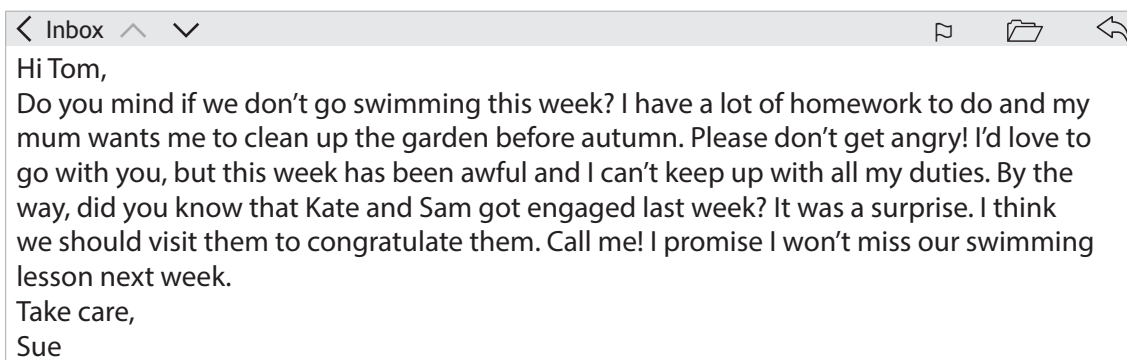
